Cognitive Stimulation Therapy (CST) for people with mild to moderate dementia:

research and practice.

Cognitive Stimulation therapy (CST) is an evidence-based, brief group treatment for people with mild to moderate dementia. It includes 14 sessions based around themed activities, yet drawing on key principles which aim to promote learning and mental stimulation. Several clinical trials, mainly in the UK, have demonstrated its significant benefits to cognition and quality of life. It has also shown to be cost effective. Guidelines have been published, outlining the process of adapting CST to different cultures and languages. Global research is starting to show how CST can be adapted and piloted in different contexts (including Italy), and demonstrate similar benefits to cognition and quality of life. In the UK, it is now recommended in government guidelines and offered as a standard treatment for people with dementia. This talk will describe the research programme of CST to date, outline its key principles and session structure, and focus on practical issues around implementation.
